Member did not like it was handled by the homegroup members and wasn't sure what we can do about this to help it not happen again. The hg member physically restrained and removed the women starting the altercation. Suggested that police be called instead of homegroup members physically removing.
- -Member stated follow up on person who started altercation has been dealt with by law enforcement.
- It is not ASC's place to dictate how homegroups handle this problem.
- Step into Recovery and Hope in Herstory need pamphlet displays and were seeking donations from homegroups who had them and didn't open up after COVID.

-Maybe make a sweeping statement on suggestions not to use physical force if an altercation arises at a homegroups meeting space.
